Below is a brief description about them and what book they teach in this Library

### **Phil Johson - Jonah**

Phil is the executive director of Grace to You. He has been closely associated with John MacArthur since 1981 and edits most of Pastor MacArthur's major books. Phil also founded several popular websites, including The Spurgeon Archive, The Hall of Church History, and the Pyromaniacs blog. He is an ordained elder and pastor at Grace Community Church.

### **Costi Hinn 1<sup>st</sup> Peter**

Costi grew up as a pastor's kid and was heavily involved in ministry but his life was completely transformed through a process that began at Dallas Baptist University in 2008, and culminated in God saving him at Mission Bible Church in 2012. Costi previously propagated "prosperity theology" His beliefs in this area have drastically changed. He is a graduate of Dallas Baptist University and Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. He is the co-author of Defining Deception, and the author of God, Greed, and the (Prosperity) Gospel.

### **Michael Staton - Haggai**

Michael is the Senior Pastor at First Baptist Church of Mustang, Oklahoma. After completing his bachelor's degree at the University of Central Oklahoma and master's degree at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, he then graduated from The Master's Seminary with a Doctor of Ministry in Expository Preaching.

## **Derek Thomas - 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel**

Dr. Thomas is a Senior Pastor he was Chairman of the Theology Department at Reformed Theological Seminary (RTS) and Minister of Teaching at First Presbyterian Church. He is from Wales. Dr. Thomas is a graduate of the University of Wales (B.Sc.), Reformed Theological Seminary (M.Div), and University of Wales/Lampeter (Ph.D.). He was ordained in the Evangelical Church of Ireland, where he served Stranmillis Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Belfast for 17 years before going to Jackson, Mississippi. Dr. Thomas served the next sixteen years in Jackson, MS, as a professor of theology at RTS Jackson, and Minister of Teaching at the historic First Presbyterian Church. Currently, Dr. Thomas is the Robert Strong Professor of Systematic and Practical Theology at RTS Atlanta and a Teaching Fellow with Ligonier ministries.

## **Nate Pickowicz - Galatians**

Pastor Nate Pickowicz (B.A., Muhlenberg College, M.A., Trinity Theological Seminary) was raised in Gilmanton Iron Works, New Hampshire.. He is the author of *Reviving New England: The Key to Revitalizing Post-Christian America* and *Why We're Protestant: An Introduction to the Five Solas of the Reformation*. He is also the general editor of *The American Puritans Series*.

## **Mike Riccardi - Philippians**

Mike Riccardi currently serves as the pastor of Local Outreach Ministries, which includes overseeing Fundamentals of the Faith classes, eight foreign language outreach Bible studies, and evangelism in nearby jails, rehab centers, and in the local neighborhood. Mike earned his B.A. in Italian and his M.Ed. in Foreign Language from Rutgers University, and his M.Div. and Th.M. from The Master's Seminary, where he is currently pursuing his Ph.D. and teaching as a faculty associate in the theology department.

## **John Piper - Hebrews**

John Piper is an American Baptist theologian, pastor, and chancellor of Bethlehem College and Seminary in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Piper taught biblical studies at Bethel University for six years (1974–1980), before serving as pastor for preaching and vision of Bethlehem Baptist Church (Converge) in Minneapolis for 33 years (1980–2013). *Desiring God* began inauspiciously in 1994 when John handed off the church's tape ministry to his assistant, Jon Bloom. What started with tapes and John's books, *Desiring God* has blossomed into an international web ministry with 12,000+ free resources and 3.5+million monthly users. Today, John serves as lead teacher for the ministry.

## **Tom Pennington - Romans**

Tom has served as Pastor-Teacher at Countryside Bible Church in Southlake, Texas since 2003. Prior to arriving in Texas, Tom served in various roles at Grace Community Church in Sun Valley, California for 16 years. His ministry at Grace included being an elder, Senior Associate Pastor, and the personal assistant to John MacArthur. Tom was also an adjunct faculty member of The Master's Seminary and Managing Director of Grace to You. Tom is a graduate of Bob Jones University and holds an honorary Doctor of Divinity (D.D.) from The Master's University. He currently serves as the Dean of the Dallas Distance Location of The Master's Seminary where he also is an adjunct professor.

## **Tom Ascol - Judges**

Tom has served as a Pastor of Grace Baptist Church since 1986. He has a BS degree in sociology from Texas A&M University (1979) and has also earned the MDiv and PhD degrees from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft. Worth, Texas. His major field of study was Baptist Theology. He has been an adjunct professor for New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary in their SW Florida extension and has also taught systematic theology and pastoral theology at Reformed Theological Seminary and the Midwest Center for Theological Studies, respectively. He is also a Teaching Fellow at the Nicole Institute for Baptist Studies at Reformed Theological Seminary in Orlando, Florida. Tom serves as the President of Founders Ministries, an organization committed to reformation and revival in local churches. He edits the Founders Journal, a quarterly theological publication of Founders Ministries, and has written numerous articles for journals and magazines. He is a regular contributor to TableTalk. He has also edited and contributed to several books. Tom regularly preaches and lectures at various conferences throughout the United States and other countries in addition to writing for the Founders Blog and Examiner.com. He entered pastoral ministry in 1989.
